**Jesus exposes the scribes who have betrayed their office. The wealthy contribute much to the collection from their surplus but the two coins from the widow are of more value before God.**

What reward do we expect from our devotion to God? The Gospel warns us about expecting lots of accolades and honors. Our worship of God originates with God's invitation. It is our response to the Lord who created us and gave us all that we are and have through his providential hand. We may enjoy seeing our name on a plaque or in a donor listing, but the Gospel this weekend reminds us that things are not essentials of faith. Rather submission to God's will and our willingness to do it is what really makes us a true believer.

### PRAYER FOR OUR VETERANS

**WORLD DAY OF THE POOR:** November 18, 2018 marks the second annual World Day of the Poor. Last year, Pope Francis suggested the Catholic Church set aside one day each year when communities can "reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel." He designated this day as the World Day of the Poor, and it will be celebrated on the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time each year. In this year's [World Day of the Poor message](#), Pope Francis reflects on Psalm 34:7, "This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him." He challenges us to use the World Day of the Poor as an opportunity to make an examination of conscience and consider whether we truly do hear the cry of the poor. In this World Day of the Poor, we join God in responding to the poor and ensuring our brothers and sisters in need that they do not feel alone or abandoned. Pope Francis says that to hear and respond to their cries, we must be in relationship and get to know people who are poor. He encourages parishes
