Jesus tells his disciples that there will be signs for his second coming. The sun, moon, stars, anguish among people, fright – these will warn of his coming. They should watch, pray and stand secure before the Son of Man.

The opening prayer for this first Mass of the new liturgical year asks God to give us the resolve to run forth to meet Christ at his coming with righteous deeds. We don't often think of the liturgy in terms of justice, but this advent season is filled with it. One day, Christ will return in his glory to judge all the world. Our preparation for his return is to live the faith we profess and to act in charity toward all our brothers and sisters. Justice will prevail when we show the love of Christ each day in all our deeds.

“Lord Jesus, help me to make time for you this Advent.”

DO NOT BE AFRAID OF CONFESSION! When was the last time you went to confession? Two weeks, two years, twenty years, forty years? If much time has passed, do not lose another day. Go, the priest will be good. Jesus is there and Jesus is more compassionate than priests, Jesus receives you, he receives you with so much love. Be courageous and go to confession!
