Has no one condemned you, woman? No one, Lord. Neither shall I condemn you. From now on, sin no more.

The story of the woman caught in adultery resonates in the headlines today. While sin is sin, at the same time an honest assessment leads us to recognize that none of us is completely pure. The corruption of sin is part of each one of us.

The blessing is that God offers us mercy and forgiveness. This gift from God is something that we all want for ourselves. But almost like selfish children, we are sometimes less inclined to share God's mercy and forgiveness with others. The hardest part of sinfulness may not be the confession and turning back to God. The most difficult part of sin may be turning toward others and forgiving them.

- APC will follow up with suggested ideas/actions of the AFC “Committee on Parishes” – include Diocese when needed
