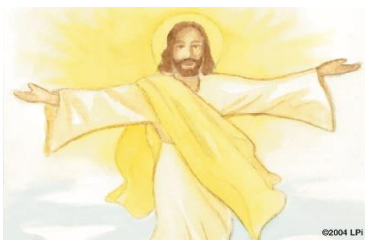

**Our hope is in God. He is our strength. Christ's Ascension gives us hope, we his people will receive the gift of wisdom and insight.**

Jesus is risen from the dead and today we celebrate his ascension into glory, where he is seated at the Father's right hand. This feast of hope is born out of the Easter celebration, but also has a resonance with Christmas as well. At Christmas we celebrated the birth of the eternal Word as one like us. Christ took on our human flesh, and in his death and resurrection forever transformed humanity. Today, as he ascends to heaven, we rejoice that we can be taken up into the kingdom of light where he reigns forever. Where he has gone, we hope to follow.

**THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS** The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Devotion to the Sacred Heart has been present since the time of the early Church. The Church Fathers considered Jesus' Heart to be the source of the sacraments of Baptism, symbolized by the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side at the Crucifixion. The devotion continued into the Middle Ages when Pope Innocent VI instituted a Mass for the Sacred Heart.
