PASTOR'S Fr. Bruno asked me to do this final Pastor's Notes. This weekend's scriptures speak to us of God's power over death. Sometimes our rescue from a serious illness appears to us as being saved from death. At other times being rescued from exhaustion or depression can have us praising and thanking God.

On Friday morning, Jon Velasquez of Mound, MN purchased the St. Andrew's school building and property. He has told us that he will use it for "storage and personal use". Even though the west entrance to the parking lot is now his property we have an easement to use it, and we gave him an easement to use the south entrance. The parking lot between the church and the school remains the property of St. Andrew's. In exchange for the parking lot, we sold him a bit more property on the north side of the block. The property line on the north side is west of the garage at the first tree along Hwy 19. The Administrative Council did meet with Jon about the property line, and we believe that he will make a good neighbor. The offer Jon made of \$30,000.00 was accepted by the Council and me. Once fees for the lawyer, surveyor and realtor were taken care of, we received \$26,385.00. In one sense, it doesn't seem like much money. On the other hand, it relieves the parish of a very large maintenance bill. I believe that the Council and the Trustees made a wise decision to sell the school. And we are grateful to Anna Dummer for her hard work in finding a buyer and taking care of so many details for us.

As I say farewell for now, I again say thank you for the warm send-off. God bless you and your new pastor, Fr. Bruno. Fr. Jeff
