It won't take long and it will give you a different perspective than hearing it in pieces. This week we hear the miracle that will give rise to discourse (dialog), the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. What Jesus did with bread and fish is what we do at Mass: took bread, blessed, broke, and gave.
