PASTOR'S By the time we get to today's part of Mark's Gospel, Jesus is a well-known person from Galilee. His fame has spread and when he returns home people have high expectations even though they grumble about his humble beginnings. Note that they call him the "son of Mary" without any reference to his father, a demeaning comment of that time. The lack of healings is a reminder that God's call requires a human response. We can't expect miracles from God without our own commitment to faith. As Paul writes to the Corinthians, God's grace is sufficient, for his power is made perfect in weakness.
"Lord Jesus I trust you no matter what."
