### **“GATHER ‘ROUND OUR TABLE”**

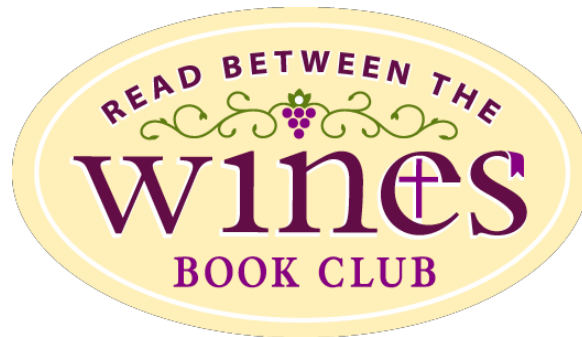
