Question: Does Thanksgiving have any Catholic origins?

Answer: Although Thanksgiving is traditional Protestant, it is interesting that the first American Thanksgiving was actually celebrated on Sept. 8, 1565 in St. Augustine, Fl. The Native Americans and Spanish settlers held a feast and the Holy Mass was offered. And, remember that "Thanksgiving" in Greek is *Eucharistia*. Thus, the Body and Blood of Christ is the true "Thanksgiving Meal."
