Question: What is the first Sacrament we receive?

Answer: Baptism

Most likely you were baptized as a baby. It is a sacrament of initiation and the first one you receive. Baptism is a sacrament that you only receive once. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) says, The Lord himself affirms that Baptism is necessary for salvation. (CCC 1257)
