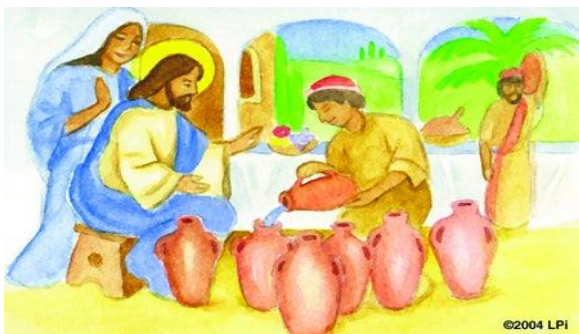

We have entered into ordinary time in the church year even as we hear in today's Gospel the last of the three traditional "epiphanies" of Jesus, the miracle at Cana in Galilee. (The other two are the manifestation to the Magi and the baptism at the Jordan.) It is a nice transition, reminding us that **Christ is to be made manifest in everyday life. The purpose of the first miracle that Jesus performed was to reveal his glory to his disciples, who then began to believe in him.** Jesus reveals himself today as well. He doesn't show up at a wedding feast with some water jugs ready to do a miracle. Instead, he shows up in the actions of Christians, through what we do and say each day. Jesus will continue to reveal himself when we act like him. It is not just bright stars in the heavens or voices from the clouds that reveal God with us. Christ can be seen in the love of two people for one other as well as in the care expressed toward others in a time of need.
