Reflection meditation

In Mark 1:14-20 we see Jesus "proclaiming the Gospel." By telling stories Jesus invited people into faith. We should each have our personal story of how we came to know and follow Christ in our back-pocket for everyday use. Driving back the day after the New Year's Eve Vikings game some friends stopped to say a quick hello. During the conversation the opportunity to share my conversion story opened up. As I shared how I encountered Jesus Christ in a personal way during my college years at the 1993 World Youth Day in Denver, Colorado, with Pope John Paul II, I realized how rusty I was. I'm brushing up. Your personal testimony should have three parts: Life before Christ. Your encounter with Christ. Your life after Christ. Those three parts should form a story that takes between 3-5 minutes to tell. The story should never glorify the sins of your past or give dirty details. It should focus on how Jesus made a difference in your life. Never push your story, but if the opportunity opens up, go for it. Have you thought about your story? Have you practiced telling your story? If your Christian testimony is in your back-pocket and ready to go, watch what Jesus will do. Others may follow Christ because they listened to you.
