

The Pharisees try to confuse Jesus. They ask about a possible conflict of giving tribute to Caesar and God. Jesus asks for a coin which has Caesar's inscription. Jesus answers by saying Give to Caesar his due and to God his due. With this answer Jesus makes a distinction between civil authority and religious authority and underlines the importance of fulfilling one's duties and responsibilities both to God and to state. Now the question is, what is Caesar's and what is not God's? Is there anything in this world that is not of God? Even Caesar and his kingdom – his rights, powers and possessions belong only to God! If a coin, struck with the image and inscription of the emperor, belongs to him, every human person created in the image and likeness of God belongs to him and only him.

Jesus is suggesting that what is essential is the acknowledgement of God's rightful place in our lives. We cannot exclude the Lord from our everyday lives.

Because of not being able to gather for Mass and for social events and have fundraisers, our All Saints AFC Well Project with Fr. Stephen at the Benedictine Monastery in Sivagangai, India had to be put aside for a few months. Thank you to any who have given donations during the pandemic; it is much appreciated! Now that we are able to be somewhat back together, and have some social gatherings, we hope that we can again try to reach our goal to reduce, or even eliminate, the \$20,000 loan the monastery has borrowed to pay for the well. The well has given the local people in the village a renewed water supply, and supplies water for the irrigation of the crops. The local people are very dependent on the crops they grow to provide a living for their families. Having the well totally paid for will allow the monastery to use their funds to help the local people in a variety of other ways. Through prayer and heartfelt consideration, we hope you will be able to give a generous donation! 100 % of the money donated to the Well Project will go to pay down the Well Project bank loan.
