Reflection meditation

God the Father blesses Jesus in Mark 9:2-10 saying, "This is my beloved Son." Fr. Scalia goes on to say, "at the Transfiguration, the Father's voice resounds to confirm what the Son had said: *Listen to him*. Peter, who wants so much to remain on the mountain, must first learn that path of the Passion. It is a command to believe Jesus' words not only about his own death and Resurrection but also about our need to follow him. Jesus is transfigured to reveal the final goal: glory. The Father's voice is heard to highlight the means to that end: the cross. The Passion is the path to glory" (*Magnificat*, February 2024). Blessings, Fr. Rolling
