Reflection meditation

Jesus cures physical and spiritual disease in Mark 1:29-39. He does it by looking problems in the face and he invites the Church to do the same. Fr. Louis Bouyer writes, "The Church is man's real educator; she forces him to look at reality, the whole of reality, in the face. But she only dares to do so because she possesses the ability to rob [the devil of his] power. . . She has no illusions about the fearsome size of the invisible forces she must fight in order to free man. However, she can fearlessly measure them. . . for she has on her side the "Stronger one" spoken of in the Gospel (Mk3:23-30), who has conquered the "strong" and deprived it of all its weapons" (Magnificat, February 2024). May Christ help you look problems in the face

KNOW A SAINT February 4 - Maria de Mattias was born in 1805 into a privileged family in a small village in Italy. Due to political and social upheaval at the time many people lacked the good quality of life that she enjoyed. But even with all of her privilege she had to teach herself to read and write because women did not receive formal education at the time. She felt a calling at a young age to change that. She believed the calling was from God and experienced a vision at 16 that ignited her passion for improving the lives of those in her community. Over the next 32 years she established

nearly 70 schools most of them in rural areas. Maria also founded the Congregation of the Sisters Adorers of the Blood of Christ. Other women joined her work forming a community that eventually opened missions throughout the world. Her commitment, compassion, and courage continue to inspire those who hear her story. She died in 1866 and was canonized in 2003 for her missionary zeal.
