Reflection meditation

There are four types of pardon given by government. A <u>full pardon</u> absolves a person of conviction and all consequences. <u>Absolute pardon</u> relieves the person of all consequence. <u>Partial pardon</u> relieves only part of the punishment or consequences. <u>Conditional pardon</u> means a requirement must be fulfilled before the pardon can take effect. That's the U.S. government. God wants to pardon us from our sin and its consequences which are disease and death. He grants Lazarus a sort of partial pardon in John 11:1-45 when he raises him from the dead. Lazarus will have to die in the end, but Christ saves him from an early death. We like Lazarus will die in the end, but Jesus Christ promises us a full pardon. If we accept and follow Jesus Christ, he will save us from our own conviction. In John 18:37, Jesus tells Pontius Pilate, "For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world."




