Reflection meditation

Lent is a time when we turn back to God like this man. Jacques Fesch was a murderer and Christ changed his life. Jacques Fesch wrote: "Yes, it is consoling to realize that a sinner like me can receive such gifts. You know my weak nature, spineless, inclining to what is evil and to the line of least resistance. If I am so filled with delights, what can we say about others who are far more willing and generous? May you too turn to the love of God. At this very moment you are fluttering around the light like a blind butterfly. You sense its nearness but you can't make your way toward it because you don't know how. I affirm hope that you too will find it. You know that I am frank with you, even if it means saying terrible things to you. Well, look - never write and never think that now you have the right to rest in an artificial and illusory life! If you thought that, you would be insulting the cross... You have to expiate and ask forgiveness from God." Jacques Fesch is being considered for sainthood. If God can set a murderer free, have hope and think of what God can do for you!

Congratulations again to all the students who received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Thank you to our religious education teachers, parents, sponsors, and especially the students who applied themselves in their preparation to receive the sacrament. Congratulations! KNOW A SAINT March 9 – Dominic Savio was born in 1842 into a peasant family in Italy. At the age 12 he was studying to be a priest with Saint John Bosco at Oratory in Turin. He impressed Don Bosco with his desire to be a priest and to help him in his work with neglected boys. A peacemaker and an organizer young Dominic founded a group he called the Company of the Immaculate Conception. As a youth, Dominic spent hours in prayer. Even in play, he said that at times, "It seems heaven is opening just above me. I am afraid I may say or do something that will make the other boys laugh." Dominic would say, "I can't do big things. But I want all I do, even the smallest thing, to be for the greater glory of God." Dominic was painfully aware that he was different from his peers. He tried to keep his piety from his

friends lest he have to endure their laughter. Even after his death at the age of 14, his youth marked him as a misfit among the saints and some argued that he was too young to be canonized. Pope Pius X wisely disagreed. For no one is too young—or too old or too anything else—to achieve the holiness to which we all are called. He was canonized in 1954.
