Reflection for Sunday, April 21

There is a youth program called Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. This Sunday's Gospel inspired an Italian educator to create the program which uses wood carvings of sheep and a shepherd to help children understand, John 10:11-18. Who are the sheep protected by the Good Shepherd? We may immediately think, it's me. It's those around me. It's the parish and youth group. All true. But is also, your grandfather who took you fishing; your grandmother who made you apple pie; your cousin who died in a car accident; a younger sibling who you taught to play Five Hundred. In other words, all the people you know and love are also protected by Christ the Good Shepherd. Anxiety is a national health issue. This is because there are lots of people who have "no concern for them." But you can help by introducing those people to a Good Shepherd, Christ, who says, "I will lay down my life for the sheep."

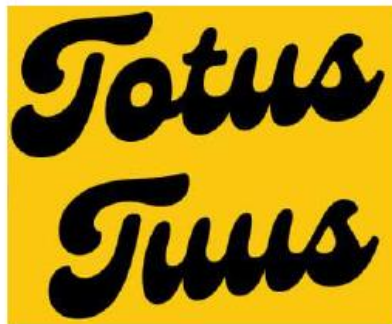
