It is important to acknowledge that it is still Easter, a season that lasts for fifty days from its first Sunday until Pentecost, which we will celebrate two weeks from now. These seven seeks are filled with the promise of new life, not just in the natural world around us, but also in the spiritual world as people are baptized and we renew our own baptism in Christ. The first reading today reminds us that from its earliest days the church has been a dynamic institution. Certainly, we rely on tradition. But at the same time, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we are a pilgrim people that journeys on the way as well. Augustine's words. "Ever ancient, ever new," applies to the institution as much as to the One who founded it. As the story in Acts of the Apostles reminds us, it is under the guidance of the Holy Spirit that the church finds its way. That Spirit is alive in all the baptized.

Under your protection we seek refuge, Holy Mother of God: do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us from every danger, O glorious and Blessed Virgin!"
