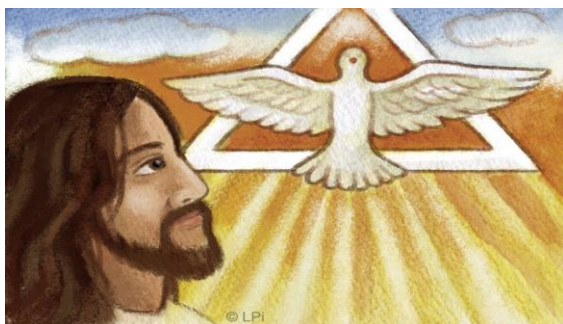

Matthew 28: 16-20 “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” It’s easy to take this formula for granted. Every time we attend Mass, we make the sign of the cross and say, “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Many of us also make the sign of the cross before meals or to begin our personal prayers. Because we are so used to hearing this Trinitarian reference to the one God in three persons, we might tend to gloss over its significance. But today, on the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we stop to remind ourselves what this really means. Perhaps the most beautiful part of this mystery of God’s nature is what it means for us. We believe in a God whose very essence is made up of loving relationships between three divine persons. It follows that, as people made in God’s image, we are to live in loving relationships. We are made to love: to love God, to love one another, and to love ourselves. Our God is not a force, a power, or an idea. Our God is a personal God who loves each of us and calls us to do the same.

THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Devotion to the Sacred Heart has been present since the time of the early Church. The Church Fathers considered Jesus’ Heart to be the source of the sacraments of Baptism, symbolized by the blood and water that flowed from Jesus’ side at the Crucifixion. The devotion continued into the Middle Ages when Pope Innocent VI instituted a Mass for the Sacred Heart. *Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on US.*
