The Eucharist we share this day (and every day) is the sacrament of Christ's body and blood broken and poured out for us. As Paul reminds the Corinthians in the second reading, this tradition comes from the Lord who commands that we do this in remembrance of him. The Mass is more than just a memorial service to the life and death of Jesus. What we celebrate each day is the real presence of Christ among us. He promised to be with us always. And through the Eucharist, he is. Our communion with him nourishes us until the day we join him at the heavenly banquet.

Today we celebrate the feast of **Corpus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ).** This feast honors the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, celebrated universally in the Catholic Church since the 13th century. As part of the 3-year Eucharistic renewal initiative of the US Catholic Bishops, the Diocese this year is also sponsoring a Corpus Christi procession that begins Sunday at 4 p.m. at the Pastoral Center and ends at the Cathedral in New Ulm. Everyone is asked to park at the Cathedral and they will have bussing available to the Pastoral Center.
