Celebrating the Passover meal was nothing new for the disciples. They shared bread and wine with family and friends at this special ritual meal every year as a part of their Jewish heritage. But on this night, Jesus changed the formula. Instead of hearing only the ancient words of the Passover prayers that his followers probably knew by heart, they heard these new, unexpected, and dramatic words: **“This is my body...This is my blood.”** Nobody had ever made such an unusual claim before. But this was more than a statement. It was a command. The gift of the Eucharist that Jesus instituted for all believers at that Last Supper is not just a sign or a symbol of Jesus' sacrifice. It is something that *we* are called to *participate* in.

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ). This feast honors the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, celebrated universally in the Catholic Church since the 13th century. St. Thomas Aquinas composed the office (the official prayers) of the Church for this feast and is widely considered one of the most beautiful in the traditional Roman breviary (the official prayer book of the Divine office or Liturgy of the Hours). It is the source of the famous Eucharistic hymns “Pange Lingua Gloriosi” and “Tantum Ergo Sacramentum” which we continue to sing today (most notable on Holy Thursday).

CONGRATULATIONS to **Joshua Bot, Nathan Hansen and Tanner Thooff** who were ordained Saturday, June 5, at the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity by Bishop Emeritus John M. LeVoir as transitional deacons. Once ordained transitional deacons, these young men will have one more year of study before being ordained to the ministerial priesthood.
