Jesus gave the Twelve Apostles a remarkable mission. He sent them out two by two to preach repentance, to cast out evil spirits, and to heal the sick. And he made them do it in a spirit of complete dependence upon God. These men - who did not even have the witness of other apostles or saints to inspire or give them courage, and who had not yet beheld the Resurrection of the Lord - stepped out into the world with literally nothing but their faith in this man named Jesus. "The twelve drove out demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them." The apostles' trust in God's power to work these miracles through their hands began with trust in God's power to provide for their own needs. This experience bolstered their faith and encouraged them in their mission. When we find ourselves questioning whether we really have the "power" to do what God wants us to do, then we ought to step back and try to depend a little more directly upon God's providence. Surrendering this element of care for ourselves allows God to meet our needs himself. And when he does, our faith will flourish too.

July is the month we honor the Precious Blood of Jesus. Falling right between June's devotion to the **Sacred Heart** and August's devotion to the Immaculate Heart, July is an ideal time to connect our devotion to Jesus and Mary into deeper gratitude for the bond they share as well as to heighten our connection to the blood of the Lamb of God.

"Let us fix our gaze on the Blood of Christ and realize how truly precious It is, seeing that It was poured out for our salvation and brought the grace of conversion to the whole world." ~ Pope Clement

The Feast of Saint Benedict is today, July 11. St. Benedict, the twin brother of St. Scholastica was born in Nursia, Italy and began his monastic life at age 16. Many disciples were drawn to him observing his sanctity, miracles, and his gift for directing souls. Benedict founded and became the abbot of Monte Cassino and organized his companions into one monastic community. His monks vested manual labor with a new dignity that comes only with prayer. Benedict's life and works profoundly affected the spirituality and life of the Church and Western civilization. Benedict was canonized in 1220. The Catholic Church venerates him as Patron of Europe.

I entered the Benedictine Monastery in Bangalore, India and professed my First Vows 25 years ago.
