Independence Day is a great United States national holiday in which Americans reaffirm their patriotism and celebrate the gifts of freedom and equality that are expressed in your Declaration of Independence. **But as Christians, we have a deeper and more fundamental citizenship that we cannot lose sight of.** As Paul tells the Philippians, **“Our citizenship is in heaven” (3:20).** While days like Independence Day may want to pull you down the path of what is often called American exceptionalism, our Christian faith demands that we acknowledge a larger reality. God favors no one and cares for all. As disciples of Christ we must do the same.
