As Christians, we may know about the wisdom and power of God, but **we often hesitate to acknowledge that this same power can be at work here in our midst.** Just as in Nazareth, *our* failure to believe can prevent God from working the mighty deeds would otherwise perform in our lives. If we don't give him the freedom of our faith, then we are closing ourselves off from the real miracle right in front of us. Instead, **let us open our hearts and our minds** to recognize the presence of God, not just in *other* places, but right here, right now.

KNOW A SAINT Thomas the Apostle - July 3

St. Thomas the Apostle had doubts about Jesus. These doubts help us to understand how important the gift of faith is. On the evening of Jesus' Resurrection Thomas was not with the other apostles in the Upper Room in Jerusalem. He was not there when Jesus appeared to them and showed them the wounds on his hands and his side. Later the other apostles told Thomas about seeing Jesus. Thomas said unless he sees the mark of the nails in his hands and puts his finger into the nail marks and puts his hand into his side he will not believe. A week later, Jesus again came to the apostles. After wishing them peace, Jesus told Thomas to look at his hands and to touch his side. He invited Thomas to believe. Thomas was ashamed that he had doubted

Jesus' Resurrection. Then Jesus said, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed". Thomas never doubted the Lord again, and he dedicated his life to helping others to believe in Jesus even though they never saw him face to face. His life teaches us to trust in everything the Lord has promised us so that we too can rise to new life as Jesus did.
