Jesus answers Peter that we are to forgive our neighbor's faults without any limit. Jesus tells the parable of the unjust steward who was forgiven a large debt by his master but refused to forgive a small debt owed to himself.

The Gospel we hear this weekend was not chosen especially for the anniversary of the attacks of September 11, 2001. This Gospel is the one assigned for today in the regular three-year cycle of Sunday readings. That being the case, as Christians, we might well ask the question, what does God want of us as we remember what happened nineteen years ago. It is easy to speak the words, "I forgive." But how deep is it in our heart? And what can we offer those who have lost loved ones, not only nineteen years ago, but in all of the tragedies since then.

"Lord Jesus, help me to let go of wrath and anger. I don't want to refuse mercy to anyone. Teach me how to forgive!"

Lean on our Faith during tough times. Be not afraid. Choosing to trust God is a decision we can each make. It comes from a determination to surrender with confidence knowing His love is enough.

We ask God's blessing on students, parents, teachers, staff, catechists and administrators as GFW Public Schools and our Religious Education programs begin. Parents are the first and primary teachers of our children in faith and morals, and I encourage all parents to take an active part in your child's faith development.

2020 INDIA WELL WATER PROJECT: This 2020 year has given us many unexpected challenges! Because of not being able to gather for Mass and for social events and have fundraisers, our All Saints AFC Well Project with Fr. Stephen at the Benedictine Monastery in Sivagangai, India had to be put aside for a few months. Thank you to any who have given donations during the pandemic; it is much appreciated! Now that we are able to be somewhat back together, and have some social gatherings, we hope that we can again try to reach our goal to reduce, or even eliminate, the \$20,000 loan the monastery has borrowed to pay for the well. The well has given the local people in the village a renewed water supply, and supplies water for the irrigation of the crops. The local people are very dependent on the crops they grow to provide a living for their families. Having the well totally paid for will allow the monastery to use their funds to help the local people in a variety of other ways. Through prayer and heartfelt consideration, we hope you will be able to give a generous donation! 100 % of the money donated to the Well Project will go to pay down the Well Project bank loan.
