Jesus teaches that the Kingdom of God is like the landowner who hires early in the morning, again at midmorning, at noon and midafternoon. At payment time, all the workers receive the same wage. How just and generous God is.

Our legal system demands justice. Contract law presumes a quid pro quo. Employer-employee relationships have an expectation of equitable compensation for work done. All of those kinds of presumptions get thrown out by the parable in this weekend's Gospel. That happens because the parable is not about balancing the scales. The fact is that we could never accomplish that in relationship to God. Rather, the parable is about how God acts: with abundant, immeasurable mercy. And we'll never be able to calculate that kind of generosity toward ourselves, or toward anyone else.

"Lord Jesus, I praise you for your mercy, which knows no bounds!"

Know A Saint - St. Padre Pio (September 23)



St. Padre Pio was born in a small farming town in Italy in 1887. His family was a strong family of faith and by the age of 5 he dedicated his life to God. Even as a small child his family reported that he loved to pray and loved the church. In early childhood he communicated with spiritual guides, angels, Jesus and the Virgin Mary. He joined an order of Friars at 15 years old and by the age of 23 was ordained as a priest. It is said that even spending a few moments in St. Padre Pio's presence was life changing. He suffered from ill

health his entire life. After offering himself as a "victim for poor sinners and souls in purgatory," at the age of 31 the wounds of Christ, appeared on his hands, feet and side remaining there painfully for 50 years. St. Padre Pio was a tireless worker of service in the church and in hospitals consistently working 19 hour days. His miraculous healings and protections from harm are legendary.

2020 INDIA WELL WATER PROJECT: This 2020 year has given us many unexpected challenges! Because of not being able to gather for Mass and for social events and have fundraisers, our All Saints AFC Well Project with Fr. Stephen at the Benedictine Monastery in Sivagangai, India had to be put aside for a few months. Thank you to any who have given donations during the pandemic; it is much appreciated! Now that we are able to be somewhat back together, and have some social gatherings, we hope that we can again try to reach our goal to reduce, or even eliminate, the \$20,000 loan the monastery has borrowed to pay for the well. The well has given the local people in the village a renewed water supply, and supplies water for the irrigation of the crops. The local people are very dependent on the crops they grow to provide a living for their families. Having the well totally paid for will allow the monastery to use their funds to help the local people in a variety of other ways. Through prayer and heartfelt consideration, we hope you will be able to give a generous donation! 100 % of the money donated to the Well Project will go to pay down the Well Project bank loan.
